Competitors in Classes 1-6 cannot compete in Classes: 10, 11 or 12

Class 2 – Beginners Designed for genuine beginners only, not to have been placed in any showjumping competition other than youngsters/lead rein before 01.01.20

Class 3 – Intro Not to have won any showjumping competition other than Beginners before 01.01.20

Class 4 – Pre-Novice Not to have won any showjumping competition other than Beginners/Intro classes before 01.01.20

Class 5 – Novice Not to have won any showjumping competition other than Beginners/Intro/Pre-Novice classes before 01.01.20

Class 7 – Improvers Not to have won any showjumping competition other than classes 1-7 prior to 01.01.20. May not enter class 10, 11 or 12 on the same day.

The welfare/fitness of the horses/ponies must be taken into account if you are considering doing numerous jumping classes. We advise that NO MORE than 3 Jumping Classes (or 6 rounds, including jump offs) should be completed in one day.

Classes may be combined if insufficient entries. Single phase may be implemented if large classes.
