All below restrictions are as a combination:

Competitors in Classes 1-6 cannot compete in Classes 9. 10, 11

Class 2 – Beginners Designed for genuine beginners only, not to have been placed in any showjumping competition other than youngsters/lead rein before 01.01.19

Class 3 – Starters Not to have won any showjumping competition other than Beginners before 01.01.19

Class 5 – Pre-Novice Not to have won any showjumping competition other than Beginners / Starters classes before 01.01.19

Class 6 – Novice Not to have won any showjumping competition other than Beginners / Starters / Intro / Pre-Novice classes before 01.01.19.

Class 8 – Improvers Not to have won any showjumping competition other than classes 1-7 prior to 01.01.19. May not enter class 11 on the same day.

The welfare/fitness of the horses/ponies must be taken into account if you are considering doing numerous jumping classes. We advise that NO MORE than 3 Jumping Classes (or 6 rounds, including jump offs) should be completed in one day.

Classes may be combined if insufficient entries.

If high level entries, we have the option to run as a 2-phase competition.
